



Waiver and Assumption of Risk

The undersigned participant (“Participant”) in the 4th Annual Edwin A. Keach Memorial Wiffle® Ball Tournament (“Tournament”) (together with his or her parent or guardian, if he or she is under the age of eighteen or under a legal disability) hereby represents, covenants and agrees as follows:

(i) The Participant acknowledges that participating in the Tournament and taking part in the physical activities associated therewith involves certain risks (some of which the Participant may not fully appreciate) and injuries, death, property damage or other harm could occur to me or others. The Participant hereby accepts and voluntarily incurs and assumes any and all risk of any injuries, damages or harm which may arise during or as a result of participating in the Tournament;

(ii) The Participant hereby waives any and all claims against the Edwin A. Keach Memorial Fund, Easton Youth Baseball and/or its or their administrators, departments, volunteers, affiliates, employees, officers, directors, trustees, agents, representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, successors and insurers (“Released Parties”) of and from any and all actions, causes of action and/or claims, whether known or unknown, which arise from or during the Tournament and/or which are caused by or relate to the undersigned’s participation in the Tournament. The Participant hereby releases and forever discharges the Released Parties from all such actions, causes of action and/or claims; and

(iii) The Participant hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties from any and all claims, damages, losses and expenses, injury, death, or accident, including court costs and attorneys’ fees, incurred by any of the Released Parties as a result of the Participant’s participation in the Tournament.
